

Dear student,

First of all, I would like to explain what families are looking for regarding language support:

- They require native English speakers in their 20s to engage in play and interact with their children at home. Typically, their children's school teachers are not native English speakers, or if they are, the classes only occur for a few hours a week. As a result, children in Spain have limited opportunities to converse with native speakers.
- If the candidate is not a native speaker, families expect someone who moved to an English-speaking country as a child. Vocabulary is primarily acquired during childhood. Additionally, my students sometimes play with the children and help their parents improve their English-speaking skills, which is why I need native or fully bilingual candidates.
- You don't need to speak Spanish for this position, as it will be conducted in English.
- Professional Appearance & Neutrality: Host families look for positive, open, and professional mentors. Since you will be working inside private family homes with children, candidates are expected to maintain a clean, professional, and neutral image during sessions (wearing simple, understated clothing and avoiding loud or disruptive attire, as well as visible religious or political symbols, accessories, or garments, to guarantee a neutral and comfortable environment for everyone).
- Lastly, families prefer American or British accents, although some may accept neutral accents.

To consider your application, we will have a two-step recruitment process. Once we complete this, I will match your profile (availability, experience, location, etc.) with a family that could be a good fit for you. The two steps are as follows:

1. A questionnaire, which takes about 15–20 minutes to complete (including background and honesty disclosures).
2. A WhatsApp video call with me, lasting around 10 minutes.
3. Documentation: Once selected, signing the Commitment Document and Acknowledgement Agreement regarding program policies, child safety, privacy, and long-term commitments. (If necessary, there may also be a mock session at my apartment before matching you with a family)

Please note that for this position, you will need to be available any evening (after around 5 PM) from Monday to Thursday to visit a family's home.

I understand that your studies in Madrid, as well as the opportunities to get to know the city and other cities in Spain, and even travel to more countries in Europe as much as possible, are your priorities. However, if you have some free time and want to enhance your experience by getting to know our culture through a family, this is the place for you!
